INSTRUCTIONS AND DEFINITIONS

Read Carefully

All information requested must be completely filled out and the landowner's signature notarized by a notary public. It is unlawful to falsify any paper or document issued to give permission for any person to take protected desert flora or to take more plants than authorized by the permit.

NOTIFICATION:

Any person proposing to remove or possess any cacti or yucca plants for commercial purposes from any state, county, or privately owned lands shall notify the State Forester Firewarden, complete this form and return it to the State Forester Firewarden for approval at least 10 days before removal or possession of the plants. It is unlawful for any person to cut, remove, or cause to be cut or removed any desert flora from any land in this State unless he has an inchoate title, or any title less than fee simple.

COMMERCIAL HARVESTING:

Removal or possession of cacti or yucca plants for commercial purposes means the removal or possession of six (6) or more of such plants in any one (1) calendar day or the removal or possession of less than six (6) of such plants for seven (7) or more consecutive calendar days. Desert flora which is removed or possessed for commercial purposes in Nevada and which is to be transported to other localities in or out of the State of Nevada must be accompanied by a shipping permit issued by the State Forester Firewarden or his duly authorized agent.

TAGGING:

A sufficient number of tags must be purchased from the State Forester Firewarden so that each plant may be tagged. The fee for each tag is \$2.00 to help defray costs to the State for enforcement of the laws regulating removal or possession of desert flora.

PROTECTED PLANTS:

The following is a partial list of some of the generally accepted common names of Nevada protected desert flora (Cacti and Yucca). Please use these names as accurately as possible. Be sure that the protected native plants that you plan to remove are actually on the land described on this application:

CACTUS:

Barrel
Cholla
Hedge Hog
Pincushion
Prickly Pear
Beaver Tail
Fish Hook

OTHER PLANTS:

Joshua Tree
Banana Yucca
Mojave Yucca
