The Las Vegas State Tree Nursery supplies plant materials adapted to the Mojave Desert. The nursery produces over 100,000 plants each year and has experience growing more than 100 different plant species. The Nursery propagates 95% of their nursery stock from seed or cuttings and grows 30% of the plant stock for sales through the Nevada Division of Forestry's Washoe State Tree Nursery located in Washoe Valley. The Nursery also provides contract and custom growing services.

The purpose of the nursery program is to provide locally adapted, affordable trees and shrubs to conserve and enhance Nevada's natural resources. Plants must be purchased for conservation purposes as provided by NRS 528.105 such as:

- Greenbelts
- Reforestation
- Wildlife habitat
- Mine reclamation
- Soil erosion control
- Windbreaks
- Post-fire rehabilitation
- Water conservation
- Wetland and riparian restoration

- Open Saturdays October 17 and 24, and November 7 and 14, 2009, 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Open Saturdays in April.
