



Common Name: Fremont cottonwood
Scientific Name: *Populus fremontii*

This tree, growing on a private ranch in Pleasant Valley (near Reno), was nominated by Curtis Coulter in 1993.

It measures 94 feet high, with a trunk circumference of 403 inches and a trunk diameter of 10 feet; it has a crown spread of 107 feet for a total of 524 points.

This tree has the widest spread of any tree on Nevada's Big Tree Register, though it is neither the tallest tree nor the widest tree. However, it is currently the largest tree in the register in terms of points.

Fremont cottonwood is native to the Southwest United States.
