



Common Name: Joshua tree
Scientific Name: *Yucca brevifolia*

This tree, at the Department of Business and Industry Building in Las Vegas, was nominated by Margie Klein in 2006.

It has a height of 23 feet, a circumference of 64 inches, and a trunk diameter of 1 ½ feet. Its spread is 18 feet, for a total of 92 points.

This tree was obviously moved here, and although Joshua tree is very common in Southern Nevada, this particular tree is unusual because it has dozens of limbs.

Joshua tree is native to the California, Nevada and Utah.
