



Common Name: Rocky Mountain ponderosa pine  
Scientific Name: *Pinus ponderosa* var. *scopulorum*

This tree, growing in Lee Canyon of the Spring Mountains (near Las Vegas), was nominated by Robert Van Pelt in 2003.

It measures 133 feet in height with a circumference of 204 inches, and a trunk diameter of 5 feet. Its spread is 57 feet, for a total of 355 points.

Native to most of the western half of the continental U.S., this tree is one of two varieties of ponderosa pines found in Nevada; the other is the Pacific ponderosa pine.
