Conservation Crew Supervisor (18 VACANCIES)

LOCATIONS: Vacant positions are based out of the nine Conservation Camps across the State in the following locations: (3) Carson City, (2) Wells, (1) Ely, (1) Three Lakes Valley, (3) Jean, (5) Carlin, (3) Winnemucca.

Job Summary: The Nevada Division of Forestry (NDF) is seeking eighteen full time Conservation Crew Supervisors. These individuals will serve as a Crew Supervisors on a hand crew performing fire suppression, fuels management, natural resource conservation and other duties under the most adverse environmental conditions. Conservation Crew Supervisors are in charge of supervising non-violent, minimum custody offenders, whom are serving time with the Nevada Department of Corrections. They are trained in and provide labor for conservation projects, community assistance, wildland fire suppression, and other emergency response activities.

Minimum qualifications: Graduation from high school or equivalent education and two years of logging, construction, ranching or physically active conservation-related experience such as tree trimming, planting, fire suppression or related activity; OR an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Conditions of Employment

- U.S. Citizenship.
- Graduation from high school or equivalent education.
- Possession of a valid driver's license.
- Ability to possess a Class B driver's license with air brake endorsement within one year of employment.
- Background investigation is required.
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Passage of a pre-employment drug testing.
- Passage of an arduous work capacity test. (3 mile walk with 45lb backpack under 45mins).
- The physical demands of this position are rigorous fieldwork requiring above average physical performance, endurance and superior conditioning. Work

requires prolonged standing, walking over uneven ground, and recurring bending, reaching, lifting and carrying of items weighing over 50 pounds and shared lifting and carrying of heavier items, and similar strenuous activities requiring at least average agility and dexterity.

- Passage of annual physical and work capacity testing is required for maintaining employment.
