NAC 528.110 Sale of plant materials to private landowners.

The criteria for eligibility for distribution of plant materials to private landowners in Nevada are:

1. The land on which the plants are to be planted must consist of a parcel containing 1 acre or more, or 2 or more contiguous parcels owned by different owners if those 2 parcels total 1 acre or more; and
 2. The land must be entirely outside the city limits of any incorporated city of this state,
- except that in Carson City, the land must be outside the designated urban area of the city.
