IRA Urban & Community Forestry Grant Program

Applicants can submit proposals for **Program Development and Urban Tree Canopy Management Projects** or **Planting and Education Projects**.

Eligibility Criteria

Projects must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Projects must occur or benefit disadvantaged communities as identified through the Climate and Economic Justice Screening Tool (CEJST).
- Programs must be working in or with students from a Title 1 school.


