The Nevada Division of Forestry (NDF) nursery program provides native and adapted plant materials, and technical assistance, to encourage private landowners and public land management agencies to make conservation plantings for windbreaks, shelter belts, woodlots, erosion control, food and cover for wildlife, post-fire restoration, and riparian restoration. Seedlings are graded and grown to sizes suitable for plantings on private and public lands. Plants purchased at the Washoe Nursery must be used for conservation purposes as provided for by NRS 528.105.
