

Conservation Education Grant



Stewardship, Conservation Education, and Forest Legacy Program

Conservation Education (CE) Grants prioritize educational programs that connect the public of all ages with the Nevada landscapes and natural resource management. CE grants offer a maximum award of \$10,000 with a 20% match requirement annually.

Programs must focus on topics of natural resource protection, restoration, conservation, preservation, and/or work force development and recruitment for land management.

Eligibility Criteria

Eligible projects must meet Federal and State Program objectives for Conservation Education, as outlined in the [2020 Nevada Forest, Range, and Watershed Action Plan](#).


Priority is given to programs that benefit underserved communities in the state of Nevada.
