Urban & Community Forestry Grants



Community Forestry Assistance Grant Program

Community Forestry Assistance (CFA) Grants prioritize projects that improve urban tree canopies, promoting equitable distribution statewide. CFA grants offer a maximum award of \$25,000 with a 20% match requirement, totaling \$100,000 in federal funding for projects across Nevada.

Applicants can submit proposals for **Program Development and Urban Tree Canopy Management Projects** or **Planting and Education Projects**.

Eligibility Criteria

Eligible projects must meet Federal and State Program objectives for Urban Forestry, as outlined in the <u>Ten Year</u> <u>National Urban and Community Forestry Action Plan</u> and/or the <u>2020 Nevada Forest, Range, and Watershed</u> <u>Action Plan</u>. Generally speaking, projects that develop, strengthen, and expand urban canopies can be submitted for consideration.
